1) CHAIRMAN’S WELCOME

2) APOLOGIES

4) DISPENSATIONS

5) PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Members considered how to respond to the following proposals:

- a) No waiting at any time and no loading at specific times in strategic locations at Wilmore Street, Barrow Street, and High Street, including loading bay on south side of Barrow Street, and disabled bay on east side of High Street. Existing waiting restrictions at these locations to be revoked.

It was PROPOSED, SECONDED and AGREED that the proposals be SUPPORTED.

- b) No waiting at any time in strategic locations at King Street, Queen Street, and Sheinton Street.

It was PROPOSED, SECONDED and AGREED that the proposals be SUPPORTED.

It was further AGREED that, at least for the first few weeks following installation, these areas should be policed and the situation be reviewed in six months time for effectiveness.
