

TOWN CRIER

Specification and Information for Applicants

The position of Town Crier for Much Wenlock is open to male and female applicants, aged 18 years and over. Applicants should be aware that the role can require extended periods of standing, outside as well as indoors, in both good and bad weather.

It is desirable that applicants possess the following:

- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- An outgoing personality
- Reasonable knowledge of the history of Much Wenlock or the willingness to acquire this
- Proven reliability
- Ability to project voice
- Strong ties to Much Wenlock
- Driving licence
- 1. All applicants must have a strong desire to be the Town Crier for Much Wenlock.
- 2. Each applicant must complete an application form in order to be considered for the role.
- **3.** The decision of Much Wenlock Town Council to accept or reject an application is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 4. Invited applicants will be required to perform a trial cry to the public on Saturday, 26th October 2024.
- **5.** All decisions made in relation to the successful applicant and appointment of the new Town Crier will be final.
- **6.** Appointment of the successful applicant will be subject to satisfactory completion of a DBS check.
