The Climate Fresk is a **LEARNING** workshop led by a community of *Freskers*, based on a game with 42 cards taken from the scientific reports of the **IPCC***. The game raises **AWARENESS** about **CLIMATE CHANGE** in a playful and collaborative way.

UNDERSTAND CLIMATE CHANGE

In the face of this emergency, everyone must be able to understand climate change, make sense of the information, form an opinion, accept the necessary changes for the preservation of life on the planet and act quickly!



THE CLIMATE FRESK: KEY FIGURES

- 1,000,000** participants
- 48,000** *Freskers*
- 120** country coordinators
- 66** countries
- 45** languages

WORKSHOP How it works

Participants gather around a table in teams of 4 to 7 people. They discover the cards representing the different components of climate change and work together to connect them in order to highlight the links between cause and effect. A *Fresker* supervises one or more teams and guides them using a collective intelligence approach. The *Fresker* then facilitates an exchange to debrief and explore individual and collective solutions and broaden reflection beyond climate issues.

WORKSHOP The ingredients

-  1 set of 42 cards
-  1 *Fresker*
-  4 to 7 people per table
-  3 hours of workshop
-  **Materials** (table, paper, markers)

WORKSHOP The 3 phases

- 1/ REFLECTION**
Discover, question, understand and connect the cards to co-construct.
- 2/ CREATIVITY**
Make connections between the cards, take ownership of the fresk and illustrate it in a context of team spirit.
- 3/ DEBRIEF**
Exchange mindfully on how participants feel, their point of view, and come up with individual and collective solutions to broaden reflection beyond climate issues.

A WORKSHOP ACCESSIBLE TO EVERYONE

The Fresk is suitable for all audiences and all levels of understanding. It addresses both novices and the more aware who wish to deepen their knowledge on climate issues.

We offer tailor-made workshops, adapted to all audiences: citizens, employees, students, public and private sector decision-makers.

The Fresk also exists in the form of a Junior Fresk for 10-14 year olds.
