#### 1. ELECTION OF TOWN MAYOR

In pursuance of LGA 1972 s15(1)(2) it was **proposed** by Cllr Susan Crooke-Williams and **seconded** by Cllr Duncan White that Cllr Daniel Thomas be elected Town Mayor for the ensuing year.

There being no other nominations, it was unanimously RESOLVED that Cllr. Daniel Thomas be elected Town Mayor of Much Wenlock for the ensuing year.
